Lower Gallery-6,000 sq-ft.

Upper Gallery-3,000 sq-ft

Theater Gallery-1,500 sq-ft.

How to apply for exhibit consideration

Portfolios may be submitted to Arvada Center for the Arts and Humanities in two ways: for general review and for special exhibitions.

General Review

Artists submitting a portfolio for general review (solo and group exhibitions) are reviewed by the gallery/museum staff.

Special Exhibitions

These include the November Craft Fair and December Art Market.

Submission Guidelines

- 10 to 20 slides, a CD or DVD of recent work
- list of related works including; titles, mediums, sizes, dates, and retail or insurance values
- artist statement pertinent to the work submitted
- resume and biographical statement
- self-addressed, stamped envelope
- If you wish to receive confirmation that your submission arrived, please include a self-addressed, stamped postcard.
- No email or fax application accepted.
