Meets generally on the second and fourth Thursdays of each month at 5:30 p.m. Appointees are paid \$75.00 per meeting. Terms are for three years. You must be a resident of the City of Arvada to apply.

 - Mock stings (no violations occur) where young looking, over 21 year old undercover police officers try to purchase alcohol for themselves and others who are not on premises as a way to educate establishments in being watchful to check ID's, control consumption and avoid being cited in stings using under 21 year old volunteers
 - Warning letters and commendation letters to licensees
