Dear Parents and Dancers,

The Spring Concerts are fun, entertaining and very professionally, yet economically, produced for both the dancers and the audience. This Information Form provides the ***basic important information*** regarding our Spring Concerts. **Please plan on attending one of the informational meetings in February for more details.**

Performing in dance concerts is a great experience, for the fun of performing and for learning to work as a team. Being your best at performance time requires many hours of classroom practice. For this reason students who miss over 30% of a class, either excused or unexcused, may not be allowed to participate in that dance.

**Who Performs:** All Arvada Center Academy Classes, as well as youth tap and hip hop perform this year.

**Mandatory Parent Meetings:** There is one informational meeting in February, scheduled on two different days for parents to receive extremely important details about the Spring Shows. A parent must attend **one** of the meetings.

**Time commitment?** Dancers **MUST** be registered and attend their classes regularly from February to June in order to perform. **All theater rehearsals and performances are mandatory.** It is especially important that dancers be in classes in February for initial costume fittings and in late April and early May for final costume fittings. Please do not plan vacations for the 2 weeks prior to the shows. If your dancer is absent from class the week of the final costume fitting, you must schedule a fitting with Patti Wagner and the Class Coordinator for another time during that week.

**Fees:** \$65 per concert series; Ballet Show is \$65; Jazz/Modern Show is \$65. This fee incorporates costume rental, the expense of lighting, adapting existing costumes, building new costumes, props and sets. This fee should be paid at the Box Office as close to February registration as possible.

**How to register for Spring Show/s:** Attached is the Registration Form and the Volunteer Form.

1. Fill out each form completely and neatly.
2. Make a check for the total amount due made payable to the *Arvada Center*.
3. Note "Spring Show fee" in the memo section of the check and whether it is for Ballet, Jazz or both.
4. **Turn the forms and your check in at the same time to the Box Office no later than February 14.**
