

Additional Unfunded Projects Costing Information

- 1) 72nd/Simms intersection improvements \$500,000. This includes the signal pole relocations and right lane enhancements described.
- 2) Bike lanes and sidewalks on Simms Street from 64th Ave to 86th Pkwy \$1.5 million. This includes widening necessary areas to achieve a continuous on street bike lane through this corridor and filling in all sidewalk gaps on both sides. A bike lane only without filling in all the sidewalk gaps would be around \$500,000.
- 3) Bridge widening north of 75th Avenue. Both bridges currently have sidewalks and bike lanes on both the east and west sides so it does not appear that widening of the bridge structures would be necessary. The road does narrow going northbound past the bridges. This road widening would be included in item 2.

Also, as a clarification the 72nd/Indiana intersection improvements did not score well during the TIP funding evaluation process and will not be receiving any funding at this time. The estimated cost for this project is \$6 million. The Ralston Road project did score well and is expected to receive roughly \$2 million in TIP funding.
