Staff Criteria

1. Legislative/legal/voter mandated obligation (Where is information located in city documentation?)
2. Quantity of citizens benefited (How is the quantity and relevance of number and citizen support arrived at?)
 - a. Who pays for development?
 - b. Does the survey best represent Arvada residents? What number is substantial—how determined?
3. How does overutilization get measured? Is the current situation (staff and police) at City Hall in this state? **How do we answer where Arvada is going or integrate vision/strategies/goals from Comp. Plan, department plans, Council goals, etc. What is the vision—how are we getting there through capital expenditure?**
4. Positive Economic impact and quality of life—how should these be measured in terms of impact?
5. Are any transportation projects currently associated with areas of poor safety or health concerns?
